DR. MARILYN RANTZ - A LIVING LEGEND


Marilyn Rantz, PhD, RN, FAAN, a Curators' Professor Emerita at the MU Sinclair School of Nursing, has made remarkable contributions to nursing and health care throughout her career.

Dr. Rantz has secured significant grant funding, totaling over \$100 million, for projects aimed at enhancing care coordination, researching long-term care, developing new care delivery models for older adults, and leveraging technology to support aging in place.

In recognition of her groundbreaking contributions, Dr. Rantz was inducted as a Living Legend by the American Academy of Nursing in fall 2020. Her sustained commitment to improving the quality of care for the elderly and her pioneering research in nursing home quality over four decades have established her as an international expert in quality measurement in nursing homes and a leading figure in the field of gerontological nursing.
